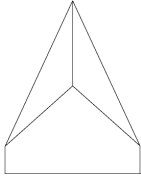
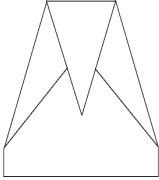


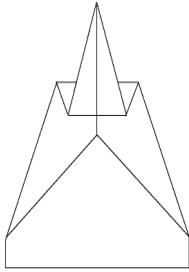
1. Place the paper with the logos face down and at the bottom.
2. Fold the piece of paper in half lengthwise and open back up. The logos should still be face down and at the bottom.
3. Fold down the top right corner to the center line just made and repeat with the top left corner.
4. Fold the top right flap down against the middle fold line again. Repeat this step with the left flap.



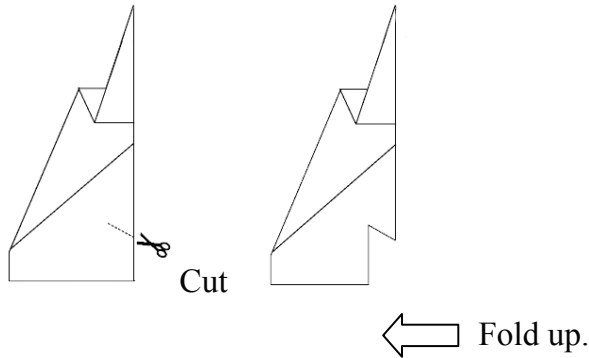
5. Next fold the nose down along the center crease so your plane looks like the figure below.



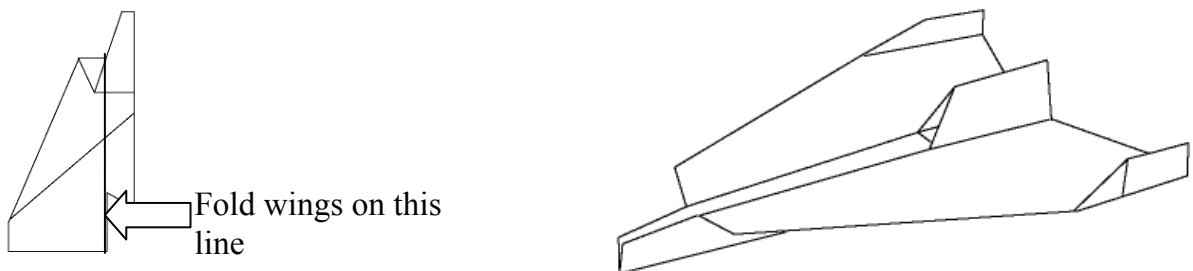
6. Fold the nose back up slightly.



7. Fold the plane in half along the crease and cut diagonally to create a flap as indicated on the first image below. Be sure to make the cut above the printed logos on the inside. Fold the portion under the cut into the middle of the plane. The plane should look like the second image.



8. Finally, fold the wings down so the crease is flush to the cut made and fold up the wing ends. (See figure). Your plane should look similar to this.
